

## **FIRST GRADE SUPPLY LIST 2017-2018**

Dear Future First Grade Parents:

Here is a list of necessary items for your first grader. Please get these supplies ready for the first day of school and label **ALL** items.

2 boxes of regular crayons - 24 count or less (NO specialty crayons, such as 'glitter')

20 glue sticks – Larger sized Elmer's glue sticks are preferred

4 four oz. bottles of Elmer's school glue – **WHITE ONLY**

24 #2 pencils with erasers - **sharpened**

\*4 folders with pockets, **no brads**

1 plastic pencil box that will fit inside a desk, and is big enough to hold scissors, 1 glue stick, 1 bottle of glue box of crayons and several pencils

Fiskar scissors - **pointed**

\*Backpack- make sure folders can fit into backpack

2 plain pink erasers

2 boxes of Kleenex (200 count)

2 boxes **washable** markers – **8 count, PRIMARY colors, and THICK markers only**

\*2 spiral notebooks - wide ruled

1 box of colored pencils – **sharpened**

2 small pencil sharpeners with a lid that catches shavings

1 12-inch ruler

2 containers of disinfecting wipes

\*Prizes for prize box (small items)

\*Items not included in the optional EPI prepackaged school supply pack.

Students will receive an art box from the teacher on the first day of school, so please send ALL supplies listed on the first day. We will store their supplies in their box.

\*\*Please be sure that your child can tie his/her shoes, zip his/her own coat, and that boys can tuck in their shirts and fasten belts.\*\*
